1- Wicked do not want to be ruled over:

1 Nephi 18:10

...wherefore, I, Nephi, began to speak to them with much soberness; but behold they were angry with me, saying: We will not that our younger brother shall be a ruler over us.

2- Bound with cords:

1 Nephi 18:11

And it came to pass that Laman and Lemuel did take me and bind me with cords.

3- Treated harshly:

1 Nephi 18:11

...they did treat me with much harshness;

4- Lord did suffer (allow) it:

1 Nephi 18:11

...nevertheless, the Lord did suffer it that he might show forth his power, unto the fulfilling of his word which he had spoken concerning the wicked.

5- The guide discontinued working:

1 Nephi 18:12

...the compass, which had been prepared of the Lord, did cease to work.

6- Great storm arose:

1 Nephi 18:13

Wherefore, they knew not whither they should steer the ship, insomuch that there arose a great storm, yea, a great and terrible tempest,

7- Three day period:

1 Nephi 18:13

...we were driven back upon the waters for the space of three days;

8- Bands were loosed:

1 Nephi 18:15

...wherefore, they came unto me, and loosed the bands which were upon my wrists,

9- Hands and feet impacted:

1 Nephi 18:15

...behold they had swollen exceedingly; and also mine ankles were much swollen, and great was the soreness thereof.

10- Praised God without murmuring:

1 Nephi 18:16

Nevertheless, I did look unto my God, and I did praise him all the day long; and I did not murmur against the Lord because of mine afflictions.

11- Parents suffer greatly due to children:

1 Nephi 18:17

...and having suffered much grief because of their children,

12- With compass we journey to the promise land:

1 Nephi 18:21-22

...behold, I took the compass, and it did work whither I desired it. And it came to pass that I prayed unto the Lord; and after I had prayed the winds did cease, and the storm did cease, and there was a great calm.

And it came to pass that I, Nephi, did guide the ship, that we sailed again towards the promised land.

1- Wicked do not want to be ruled over:

Helaman 12:6

Behold, they do not desire that the Lord their God, who hath created them, should rule and reign over them; notwithstanding his great goodness and his mercy towards them, they do set at naught his counsels, and they will not that he should be their guide.

2- Bound with cords:

John 18:12

Then the band and the captain and officers of the Jews took Jesus, and bound him.

3- Treated harshly:

Luke 22:63-4

And the men that held Jesus mocked him, and smote him.

And when they had blindfolded him, they struck him on the face, and asked him, saying, Prophecy, who is it that smote thee?

4- Lord did suffer (allow) it:

1 Nephi 19:9

And the world, because of their iniquity, shall judge him to be a thing of naught; wherefore they scourge him, and he suffereth it; and they smite him, and he suffereth it. Yea, they spit upon him, and he suffereth it, because of his loving kindness and his long-suffering towards the children of men.

5- The guide discontinued working:

Mark 15:37

And Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost.

6- Great storm arose:

3 Nephi 8:5

And it came to pass in the thirty and fourth year, in the first month, on the fourth day of the month, there arose a great storm, such an one as never had been known in all the land.

7- Three day period:

3 Nephi 8:20-23

And it came to pass that there was thick darkness upon all the face of the land, insomuch that the inhabitants thereof who had not fallen could feel the vapor of darkness...

And it came to pass that it did last for the space of three days that there was no light seen; and there was great mourning and howling and weeping among all the people continually; yea, great were the groanings of the people, because of the darkness and the great destruction which had come upon them.

8- Bands were loosed:

Alma 11:42

Now, there is a death which is called a temporal death; and the death of Christ shall loose the bands of this temporal death, that all shall be raised from this temporal death.

9- Wrists and ankles impacted:

3 Nephi 11:15

And it came to pass that the multitude went forth, and thrust their hands into his side, and did feel the prints of the nails in his hands and in his feet; and this they did do, going forth one by one until they had all gone forth, and did see with their eyes and did feel with their hands, and did know of a surety and did bear record, that it was he, of whom it was written by the prophets, that should come.

10- Praised God without murmuring:

D&C 19:19

Nevertheless, glory be to the Father, and I partook and finished my preparations unto the children of men.

11- Parents suffer greatly due to children:

D&C 27:2

For, behold, I say unto you, that it mattereth not what ye shall eat or what ye shall drink when ye partake of the sacrament, if it so be that ye do it with an eye single to my glory—remembering unto the Father my body which was laid down for you, and my blood which was shed for the remission of your sins.

12- With compass we journey to the promise land:

Acts 4:10

Be it known unto you all, ...that...Jesus Christ... is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner.

Neither is there salvation in any other; for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.
