LOOK (Webster's 1828) to direct one's eyes, to search

The Spirit of the Lord directs Nephi's vision with the command "to look" - 13 different times

Nephi responds during his vision from being directed by the Spirit of the Lord with—"I looked," "I saw," "I beheld,"— 88 different times
