

Perfect Pattern of Prophetic Warning and its Conditions and Consequences

1st Prophetic Warning and its Conditions and Consequences (Mosiah 11:20-25)

"...except they repent" (11:20, 21, 23, 25) (4 times)

1. You shall be delivered into the hands of your enemies or brought into bondage (11:21, 23)
2. You shall suffer affliction at the hands of your enemies (11:21)
3. God shall be slow to hear your cries (11:24)
4. You shall be smitten by the hand of your enemies (11:24)
5. God shall not hear your prayers (11:25)

2nd Prophetic Warning and its Conditions and Consequences (Mosiah 12:2-8)

(Result of ignoring God's first warning, first conditions and consequences are imminent... new conditions and consequences set forth)

Mosiah 12:2

1. You shall be brought into bondage (7:33)
2. You shall be smitten on the cheek (21:3)
3. You shall be driven by men (21:8, 11, 13)
4. You shall be slain (21:8, 11, 13)
5. Your flesh will be devoured by the vultures, dogs and wild beasts (?)

Mosiah 12:3

6. The life of king Noah will be valued as a garment in a hot furnace, [his life will be of no worth] (19:20) and he shall know that I am God (11:27)

Mosiah 12:4

7. You will be smitten with sore afflictions (21:15-16)
8. You will know famine (21:16-18)
9. You will know pestilence (21:16-18)
10. You shall howl all the day long (21:9-11)

Mosiah 12:5

11. You shall have burdens lashed upon your backs and be driven like a dumb ass (21:3, 13)

Mosiah 12:6

12. You will be smitten by hail (7:30)
13. You will be smitten with the east wind [destroying wind] (7:31)
14. You will be pestered by insects who will devour your grain (21:16-18)

Mosiah 12:7

15. You will be smitten with a great pestilence (21:16-18)

"...and if you still don't repent - then you will be utterly destroyed off the face of the earth" (12:8, 12)

7 Degrees of Bondage	
<u>Alma's Group</u>	<u>Limhi's Group</u>
1. Lord placed them in bondage but with no bloodshed (23:35-38; 24:9)	1. Lord placed them in bondage with much bloodshed (21:5-12)
2. Lord was not slow to hear their cries (24:10-13)	2. Lord was slow to hear their cries (21:15)
3. Lord physically eased their burdens (24:14-15)	3. Lord softened the hearts of the Lamanites so they eased their burdens (21:15)
4. Lord visited them in their affliction (24:14)	4. Lord allowed them to prosper in degrees according as their faith increased (21:16)
5. Lord delivers them (24:16)	5. Lord allows Gideon to devise a plan of escape (22:9)
6. Lord put the guards asleep for them (24:19)	6. Lord allows the Lamanite guards to be drunken (22:7, 10)
7. Lord leads them to Zarahemla (24:23-25)	7. Lord allows Ammon to lead them to Zarahemla
